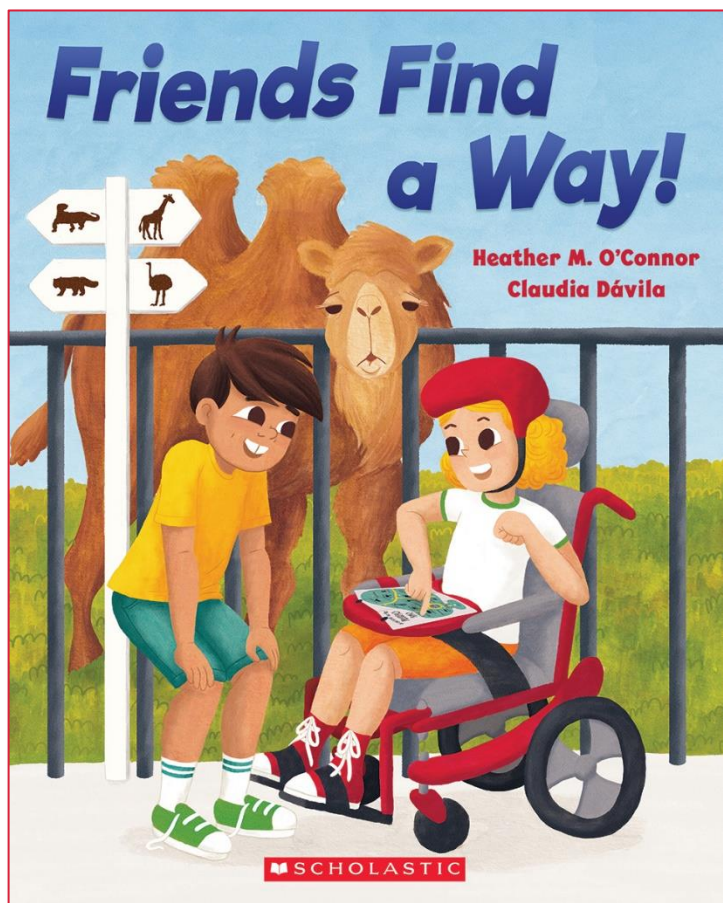


Suze and Tyson are back in this heartwarming follow-up to *Fast Friends!*

But Suze does. Can she lead the way back?

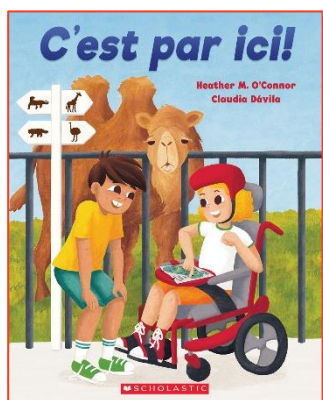
A wonderful, energetic story about friendship and inclusion, which also introduces kids to concepts of non-verbal communication and reading body language.
